Pence also said that the U.S. will continue to work with Japan, China and other allies in the region to put pressure on North Korea to stop its nuclear program.

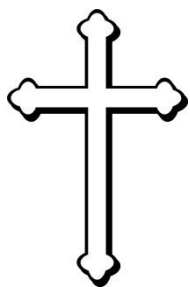
